



MARSHMALLOW OR COTTON BALL SNOWFLAKE ARTWORK

MATERIALS:

ONE SHEET OF BLUE CONSTRUCTION PAPER (YOU CAN USE ANY COLOR YOU HAVE, EXCEPT WHITE.)

WHITE SCHOOL GLUE

PAINT BRUSH AND SMALL PLASTIC BOWL OR CUP FOR GLUE (OPTIONAL)

MARSHMALLOWS (SMALL OR LARGE) OR COTTON BALLS

GLITTER, ANY COLOR (OPTIONAL)

BAKING SHEET OR PAN WITH SIDES, LARGE ENOUGH TO FIT THE PAPER (OPTIONAL)

DIRECTIONS:

1. GATHER THE MATERIALS AND PLACE THE CONSTRUCTION PAPER ON A FLAT WORK SURFACE.

2. SQUEEZE THE GLUE ONTO THE PAPER IN LINES IN THE SHAPE OF THE SNOWFLAKE OR SNOWFLAKES YOU WANT TO MAKE. IF IT IS EASIER, SQUEEZE THE GLUE INTO A SMALL PLASTIC BOWL OR CUP AND USE A PAINTBRUSH TO PAINT THE GLUE ONTO THE PAPER IN THE SNOWFLAKE SHAPE OR SHAPES YOU WANT.

3. PLACE MARSHMALLOWS OR COTTON BALLS ON THE GLUE LINES YOU HAVE MADE. IF YOU USE MARSHMALLOWS, YOU CAN EAT A FEW AS A TREAT WHILE YOU WORK. DON'T EAT THE COTTON BALLS AND DON'T EAT THE MARSHMALLOWS AFTER YOU HAVE GLUED THEM!

4. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO ADD GLITTER TO YOUR ARTWORK FOR SOME EXTRA WINTER SPARKLE, SQUEEZE OR PAINT GLUE AROUND OR ON THE SNOWFLAKE OR SNOWFLAKES YOU MADE WITH THE MARSHMALLOWS OR COTTON BALLS. THEN SPRINKLE GLITTER ONTO THE GLUE. TO CONTAIN THE GLITTER, YOU CAN PUT THE CONSTRUCTION PAPER YOU ARE USING INSIDE OF A BAKING SHEET OR PAN WITH SIDES BEFORE YOU SPRINKLE IT.

5. WAIT FOR THE GLUE TO DRY THEN CAREFULLY SHAKE OFF THE EXTRA GLITTER THAT DID NOT STICK.

6. HANG UP YOUR SNOWFLAKE ARTWORK TO DECORATE YOUR HOUSE OR GIVE IT AS A GIFT TO SOMEONE SPECIAL.
